

FY20 CDI RFP: Phase 1 Voting

151 ballots cast.

Electors could rank up to top 15 choices.

Borda Count method was used. We had $N = 24$ total statements. N (24) points were assigned for rank 1, $N-1$ (23 pts) for rank 2, and so on down to $N-14$ (10 pts) for rank 15.

We can see raw voting results but not who is associated with what ballot. A little less than half of voters ranked a full 15 statements. Smaller numbers of voters only ranked 1-14 statements and there were no trends in particular statements being voted on singularly.

We received some good suggestions for improving the community voting process.

FY20 CDI RFP: next steps

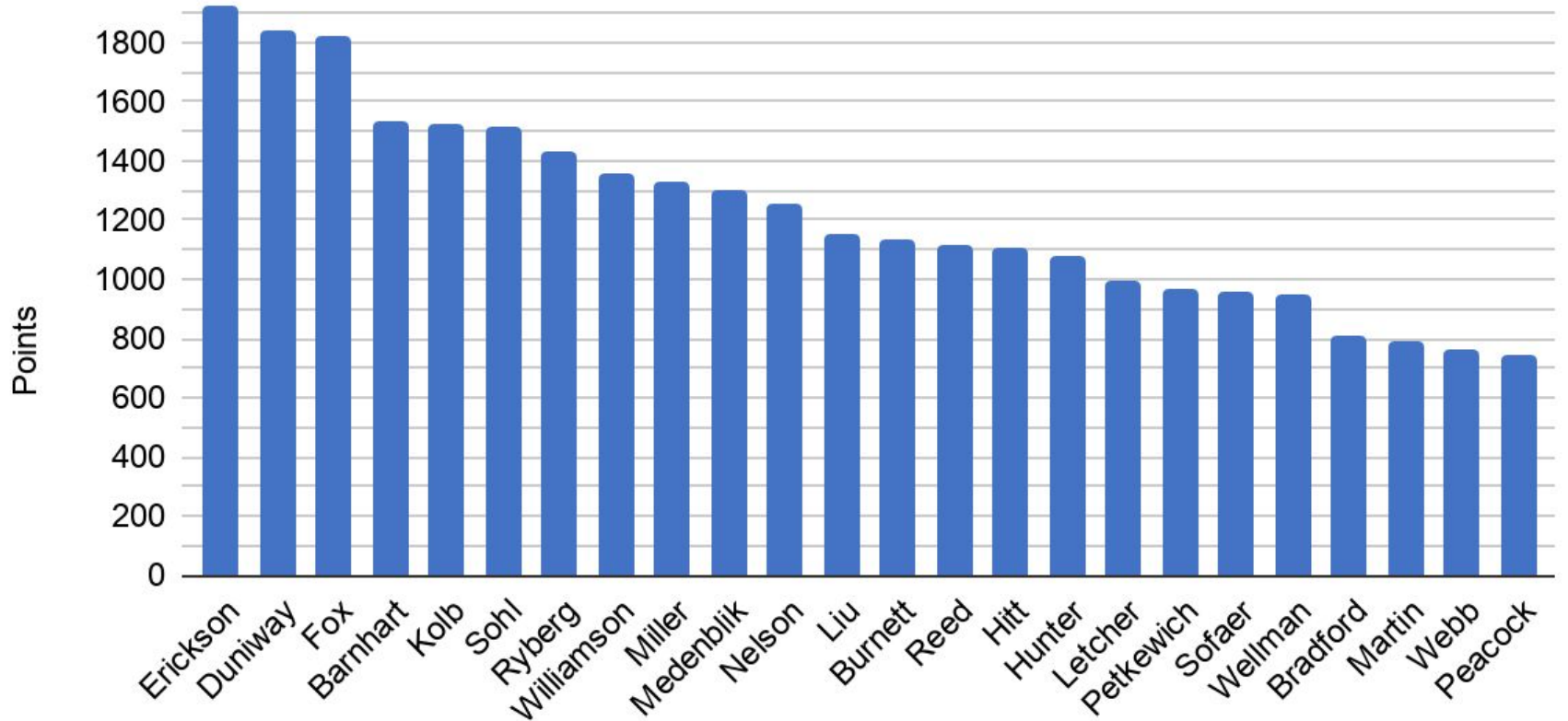
We will meet with Kevin Gallagher and Tim Quinn next week to brief them on the voting results.

Top-ranked statements will advance to Phase 2. IN ADDITION, any proposals that strongly address Bureau priorities may advance to Phase 2. In recent years we have had 17-20 statements advance.

PIs will be notified shortly after as to whether they are invited to submit a full proposal (due at the end of January). Full proposals are evaluated by a formal review panel.

Projects that do not advance are encouraged to speak with CDI coordinators about how to modify their statement to better fit the needs of the community for the next RFP.
