

Comments and Q&A for the 2016 Virtual Training: Reviewing Metadata

1. **Regarding text editors that show line numbers:** Notepad ++ is for PC machines only. For Macs you can use a couple of Bares Bones Software products: BBEdit (free 30-day trial, then \$) or TextWrangler (less powerful, but free), both downloadable at <http://www.barebones.com/products/textwrangler/download.html>. Another option: TextEdit, which is the text editor app that comes on Macs, doesn't list the line numbers; however, you CAN go directly to a line number by hitting cmd-L, which brings up a small window in which to type the line number.
2. **Is there a document somewhere that lists what each element should say? EX How he added /Time to the end of the date line. How would we know what to add/change things to in order for it to be correct?** Look for this information in the Standard, for example the [FGDC CSDGM Standard](#).
3. **Regarding metadata validation with mp:** When using the OME, would should not expect to find some of the errors Peter is pointing out like misplaced elements.
4. **Are there a collection of best example statements of 'Logical_consistency_report'?** Not right now, but if this is a need, then the presenters will look into making such a collection available.
